#### Unit test plan for the Frontpage Manager

- 1 Mark an article and click on the „Unpublish“-button  
->*Expected result:* On the frontpage the marked article disappears.
- 2 Mark some articles and click on the „Unpublish“-button  
->*Expected result:* On the frontpage the marked articles disappear.
- 3 Mark an article and click on the „Publish“-button  
->*Expected result:* On the frontpage the marked article appears.
- 4 Mark some articles and click on the „Publish“-button  
->*Expected result:* On the frontpage the marked articles appear.
- 5 Click on the small Up-Arrow in the „Order“-field  
->*Expected result:* On the frontpage the article will appear one article higher than before.
- 6 Click on the small Down-Arrow in the „Order“-field  
->*Expected result:* On the frontpage the article will appear one article lower than before.
- 7 Change the Access Level of an article to Public by clicking on the entry in the „Access Level“-field  
->*Expected Result:* On the frontpage the article will appear for all people.
- 8 Change the Access Level of an article to Registered by clicking on the entry in the „Access Level“-field  
->*Expected Result:* On the frontpage the article will only appear for registered people.
- 9 Change the Access Level of an article to Special by clicking on the entry in the „Access Level“-field  
->*Expected Result:* On the frontpage the article will only appear for people who are at least front-end author's.
- 10 Mark an article and click on the „Remove“-button  
->*Expected result:* On the frontpage the marked article disappears.
- 11 Mark some articles and click on the „Remove“-button  
->*Expected result:* On the frontpage the marked articles disappear.
- 12 Mark an article and click on the „Archive“-button  
->*Expected result:* On the frontpage the article disappears.

- 13 Mark some articles and click on the „Archive“-button  
->*Expected result*: On the frontpage the marked articles disappear.
- 14 Go to Content/Article Manager and click on the button in the „Front Page“-field of an article that isn't on frontpage yet  
->*Expected Result*: On the frontpage this article appears.
- 15 Go to Content/Article Manager and click on the button in the „Front Page“-field of an article that is on frontpage yet  
->*Expected Result*: On the frontpage this article disappears.
- 16 Add a new article, set the „Start Publishing“-date to 2007-12-24 and publish it on frontpage  
->*Expected Result*: On the frontpage the new article appears on 2007-12-24
- 17 Add a new article, set the „Finish Publishing“-date to 2007-12-24 and publish it on frontpage  
->*Expected Result*: On the frontpage the new article appears now and disappears on 2007-12-24
- 18 Add a new article, set the „Start Publishing“-date to 2007-12-24 and the „Finish Publishing“-date to 2007-12-26 and publish it on frontpage  
->*Expected Result*: On the frontpage the new article appears on 2007-12-24 and disappears on 2007-12-26
- 19 Edit an frontpage article and set the „Start Publishing“-date to 2007-12-24  
->*Expected Result*: On the frontpage the edited article disappears until 2007-12-24
- 20 Edit an frontpage article, set the „Finish Publishing“-date to 2007-12-24  
->*Expected Result*: On the frontpage the edited article disappears on 2007-12-24
- 21 Edit an frontpage article, set the „Start Publishing“-date to 2007-12-24 and the „Finish Publishing“-date to 2007-12-26 and publish it on frontpage  
->*Expected Result*: On the frontpage the edited article disappears until 2007-12-24. Then it appears, and disappears on 2007-12-26
- 22 Create a new article with a "Read more" break, set the Mainmenu Home menu item parameter "Show Unauthorized Links" to Yes and the access level of the article to „Registered“  
->*Expected Result*: On the frontpage the new article appears with a „read more“-link to registered users and with a „Register to read more“-link to unregistered or logged out users.
- 23 Create a new article with a "Read more" break, set the Mainmenu Home menu item parameter "Show Unauthorized Links" to No and the access level of the article to „Registered“  
->*Expected Result*: On the frontpage the new article appears with a „read more“-link to registered users and doesn't appear to unregistered or logged out users.
- 24 Go to Menu/Main Menu/Home and set the item parameter „Show Article Title“ to No  
->*Expected Result*: On the frontpage the article titles of all frontpage articles disappear.
- 25 Go to Menu/Main Menu/Home and set the item parameter „Show Article Title“ to Yes  
->*Expected Result*: On the frontpage the article titles of all frontpage articles appear.
- 26 Go to Menu/Main Menu/Home and set the item parameter „Title Linkable“ to Yes  
->*Expected Result*: On the frontpage the article titles of all frontpage articles are linked to the articles in single article layout.
- 27 Go to Menu/Main Menu/Home and set the item parameter „Title Linkable“ to No  
->*Expected Result*: On the frontpage the article titles of all frontpage articles are unlinked.
- 28 Go to Menu/Main Menu/Home and set the item parameter „Author Name“ to Show  
->*Expected Result*: On the frontpage the author names appear at all frontpage articles.
- 29 Go to Menu/Main Menu/Home and set the item parameter „Author Name“ to Hide  
->*Expected Result*: On the frontpage the author names disappear at all frontpage articles.
- 30 Go to Menu/Main Menu/Home and set the item parameter „Created Date and Time“ to Show  
->*Expected Result*: On the frontpage the created date and time appear at all frontpage articles.

- 31 Go to Menu/Main Menu/Home and set the item parameter „Created Date and Time“ to Hide  
->*Expected Result*: On the frontpage the created date and time disappear at all frontpage articles.
- 32 Go to Menu/Main Menu/Home and set the item parameter „Modified Date and Time“ to Show  
->*Expected Result*: On the frontpage the modified date and time appear at all frontpage articles.
- 33 Go to Menu/Main Menu/Home and set the item parameter „Modified Date and Time“ to Hide  
->*Expected Result*: On the frontpage the modified date and time disappear at all frontpage articles.
- 34 Go to Menu/Main Menu/Home and set the item parameter „Read more...Link“ to Show  
->*Expected Result*: On the frontpage the read more link appears at all frontpage articles.
- 35 Go to Menu/Main Menu/Home and set the item parameter „Read more...Link“ to Hide  
->*Expected Result*: On the frontpage the read more link disappears at all frontpage articles.
- 36 Go to Menu/Main Menu/Home and set the item parameter „Icons“ to Hide  
->*Expected Result*: On the frontpage text links appear instead of icons for PDF, Print and Email function at all frontpage articles.
- 37 Go to Menu/Main Menu/Home and set the item parameter „Icons“ to Show  
->*Expected Result*: On the frontpage icons appear instead of text links for PDF, Print and Email function at all frontpage articles.
- 38 Go to Menu/Main Menu/Home and set the item parameter „Icons“ to Use Global  
->*Expected Result*: On the frontpage the icons behave like configured in Content/Article Manager/Preferences.
- 39 Go to Menu/Main Menu/Home and set the item parameter „PDF Icon“ to Hide  
->*Expected Result*: On the frontpage the PDF function disappears at all frontpage articles.
- 40 Go to Menu/Main Menu/Home and set the item parameter „PDF Icon“ to Show  
->*Expected Result*: On the frontpage the PDF function appears at all frontpage articles.
- 41 Go to Menu/Main Menu/Home and set the item parameter „PDF Icon“ to Use Global  
->*Expected Result*: On the frontpage the PDF function behaves like configured in Content/Article Manager/Preferences.
- 42 Go to Menu/Main Menu/Home and set the item parameter „Print Icon“ to Hide  
->*Expected Result*: On the frontpage the print function disappears at all frontpage articles.
- 43 Go to Menu/Main Menu/Home and set the item parameter „Print Icon“ to Show  
->*Expected Result*: On the frontpage the print function appears at all frontpage articles.
- 44 Go to Menu/Main Menu/Home and set the item parameter „Print Icon“ to Use Global  
->*Expected Result*: On the frontpage the print function behaves like configured in Content/Article Manager/Preferences.
- 45 Go to Menu/Main Menu/Home and set the item parameter „E-mail Icon“ to Hide  
->*Expected Result*: On the frontpage the e-mail function disappears at all frontpage articles.
- 46 Go to Menu/Main Menu/Home and set the item parameter „E-mail Icon“ to Show  
->*Expected Result*: On the frontpage the e-mail function appears at all frontpage articles.
- 47 Go to Menu/Main Menu/Home and set the item parameter „E-mail Icon“ to Use Global  
->*Expected Result*: On the frontpage the e-mail function behaves like configured in Content/Article Manager/Preferences.
- 48 Go to Menu/Main Menu/Home and set the item parameter „Page Title“ to „Hello and Goodbye“  
->*Expected Result*: On the frontpage the page title „Hello and Goodbye“ appears.
- 49 Go to Menu/Main Menu/Home and set the item parameter „Show Page Title“ to No  
->*Expected Result*: On the frontpage the page title disappears.
- 50 Go to Menu/Main Menu/Home and set the item parameter „Show Page Title“ to Yes  
->*Expected Result*: On the frontpage the page title appears.
