mosHTML::CloseButton

Displays a standard close button for a pop-up window. The text on the button will be taken from the current language settings.

Syntax

```
void CloseButton ( object &$amp;params [, boolean $enable] )
```

\$params is a parameters object. If \$params->get('popup') is false then this function will not produce any output.

\$hide_js is a flag. If true then this function will not produce any output. This flag is optional and if omitted will default to false.

Examples

Example:

```
// Set-up the parameters object.  
$params = & new mosParameters( " );  
$params->def( 'popup', true );
```

```
// Draw the Close button.  
mosHTML::CloseButton( $params );
```
