mosHTML::BackButton

Displays a standard back button. The text for the button will be taken from the current language settings. The button is created with a CSS class of 'back_button'.

Syntax

```
void BackButton ( object &$amp;params [, boolean $enable] )
```

\$params is an object of type mosParameters. If \$params->get('back_button') is false then this function will not produce any output. If \$params->get('popup') is true then this function will not produce any output (in other words, the back button will be suppressed if the window is a pop-up).

\$hide_js is a flag. If true then this function will not produce any output. The flag is optional and if omitted will default to false.

ExamplesExample: This example uses the global configuration 'back_button' setting.
global \$mainframe;

```
// Set-up the parameters object.  
$params = & new mosParameters( " );  
$params->def( 'back_button', $mainframe->getCfg( 'back_button' ));  
$params->def( 'popup', false );
```

```
// Draw the Back button.  
mosHTML::BackButton( $params );
```
